MINISTERING TO YOUNG PEOPLE 😊

During this summer, we spoke to a local Christian ministry to children about our Youth With A Mission Coatesville Prayer Covenant. We encouraged them to pick a street, to pray for it, and to ask God how to minister to people there somehow. This is the same covenant challenge we present to Christians in our city. It is unrealistic to isolate children from God's Word until a certain age, and then somehow expect them to automatically understand, agree, and embrace it as an adult all of the sudden. It is better to continuously build them up over all their years with God's spiritual food, just as we do with physical food and emotional food. Jesus Christ was intentional about ministering to children and so are we. Children face more challenges than ever, and it is the Biblical responsibility of Christians to specifically care for them in the way that God wants them raised so they can live blessed in God's will.



BACK TO SCHOOL ... SOMEONE IS IN BIG TROUBLE 🙏

A number of churches and missionary organizations in our city are aggressively targeting the school district in intercessory prayer and strategic action in greater ways and unity than ever before. As local Pastors and ministry leaders, we have been interfacing with people including the Superintendent of Schools, school staff, and the heart of the matter: students. We refuse to allow school related problems to be the determining factor in the lives of the children. As God's people, we have the spiritual authority plus Jesus' mandate to have God's kingdom (administration) and God's will be done here... actually and literally. It needs to be clarified (because the English language does not) that there is a major difference in the Bible between authority and power (*exousia* and *dunamis*, respectively, in New Testament Greek). Power is a gift of provision from God to people He chooses and includes most Biblical miracles. Authority is sovereign administration from God but is not a gift: it increases by living an intimately consecrated personal life with God. The Bible reveals God's authority is what removes diseases, demons, and strongholds. God does not retract His gifts (Romans 10:29), so evil forces still have gifts from God... but God's authority exceeds all powers, so Christians have work to do. School is

a target for good and evil (the absence of good) because children are the future. John 10:10 describes the conflict, and Christians successfully minister God's life to others when they are filled with God's power, love, and discipline (2 Timothy 1:7). The root word of this 'discipline / self-control' is the Greek word *sozo* which includes: salvation, deliverance, protection, healing, preservation, doing well and being made whole! Diligent Bible study (2 Timothy 2:15) reveals this vital information left out by the English language, and equips us for spiritual victory in life. Therefore, knowing our spiritual authority, the **SOMEONE IN BIG TROUBLE** in the school is the devil; simply because Christians, with child-like faith, wage war and win battles for school children with their love, prayer, and action. Once Christians understand God's authority and power Jesus paid for: praying, fasting, and winning spiritual battles become **DESIRED** as in Luke 10:1-22 and not a duty. So **BACK TO SCHOOL** we go! Join us somehow!

OVER OUR HEADS 

Our Youth With A Mission Coatesville Neighborhood Center (YWAM CNC) is a commercial building we minister from in the heart of the city of Coatesville, PA at 752 East Lincoln Highway. It needs roof repairs, so we obtained contractor quotations for the reconstruction. Please specify the intention for your donation as the **YWAM CNC Roof Repair**. The website has a place to specify your intention, and per the IRS: mailed donations should not have the intended project or person written on the check itself, but rather on a separate paper enclosed along with the check. The primary construction quotes add up to \$7,600. Additional funds are needed after the rooftop repairs are completed to repair drywall damaged from the existing roof leaks. Our business office is finalizing a detailed letter (which we will send you soon) but we wanted to give you, our personal friends, a 'heads up' about this issue that is 'over our heads'. We will repair the interior ourselves to save money, but the external reconstruction does require professional equipment and expertise. It will be a big relief to have this fixed, especially during heavy rains  and melting snow  which currently damage our ceilings, walls and floors. **Thank you!!!**
