Since our last newsletter, several local churches collected over \$1,000 in quarters, met together, formed personality-diverse groups, and visited several local laundromats to minister to the poor in a variety of ways. Our group used \$339 in 3 hours and ministered to folks in many relational ways. This







is the second time we did this; the first was on a Monday night, and this time was on a Saturday morning. Until these outreaches, many of us did not realize how high the cost of using these places has risen. People there were extremely grateful, and also wanted to know why we were doing this with our sunny Saturday morning. Everyone needs to know that they matter, especially the poor

and the marginalized. Giving is authenticated when we give to those who can never pay us back. Jesus Christ modeled this for us by loving us, His enemies at the time, and made us into His friends!

We are very thankful for this new home and the Amish community we live in. It is a blessing to be surrounded by fields: to wake up in the morning and see cows and horses in our "backyard", horse drawn buggies, teams working in the fields, and also to walk on lower traffic roads together. We are



also very thankful we do not have to work on the farm we currently live on, as we did on another for about 3 years. In this photo, Loren and I offered to help move a newborn bull calf and his mom from the pasture (where he was born) across the street to the barn. Sometimes we drive the Amish family (who live in the main part of the house we rent part of) places too far to travel with their horse and buggy. Please pray that God leads us in our involvement with this Amish community. We have been invited to a couple of already.
