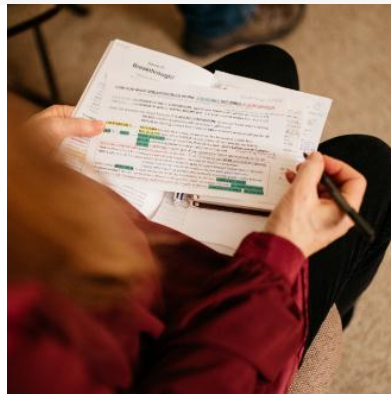




Bring it home

Typically, we meet at our YWAM Coatesville Neighborhood Center and this was a nice change.
